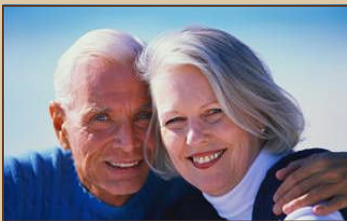


The Ultimate Gifts of Support

Proper estate planning may increase your current income, bypass capital gains tax, reduce current income tax, reduce estate tax, and retain assets for those you love.



The CCM Legacy Fund

The Legacy Fund is a quasi-endowed gift fund. It operates like an Endowed Gift Fund, such that an annual spendable income is calculated and available for distribution. However, unlike the Endowed Gift Fund, the entire balance may be made available for distribution if needs arise.

Choose this gift fund if you are interested in providing continuing support for the charitable purposes of CCM yet maintaining the flexibility for the organization to react to current needs or situations as they arise.



The CCM Permanently Endowed Fund

The Endowed Fund is a permanent gift fund. Its assets are held irrevocably by the Foundation and are managed to accomplish the identified charitable purposes. Endowed Gift Funds are designed to be preserved in perpetuity, so only the annual spendable income is available for distribution.

Choose this gift fund if you are interested in establishing a permanent legacy by providing continuing support for the charitable purposes of Cooperative Christian Ministry.

Cooperative Christian Ministry's (CCM) crisis assistance programs are the front line of response to families struggling to provide food, shelter, and financial stability.

In June of 2008, the Board of Directors of CCM, recognizing the impending need, adopted a Strategic Plan for expanding services to meet the needs of our community. Emergency and crisis services were expanded and the most vulnerable in our community received food, shelter and financial assistance.

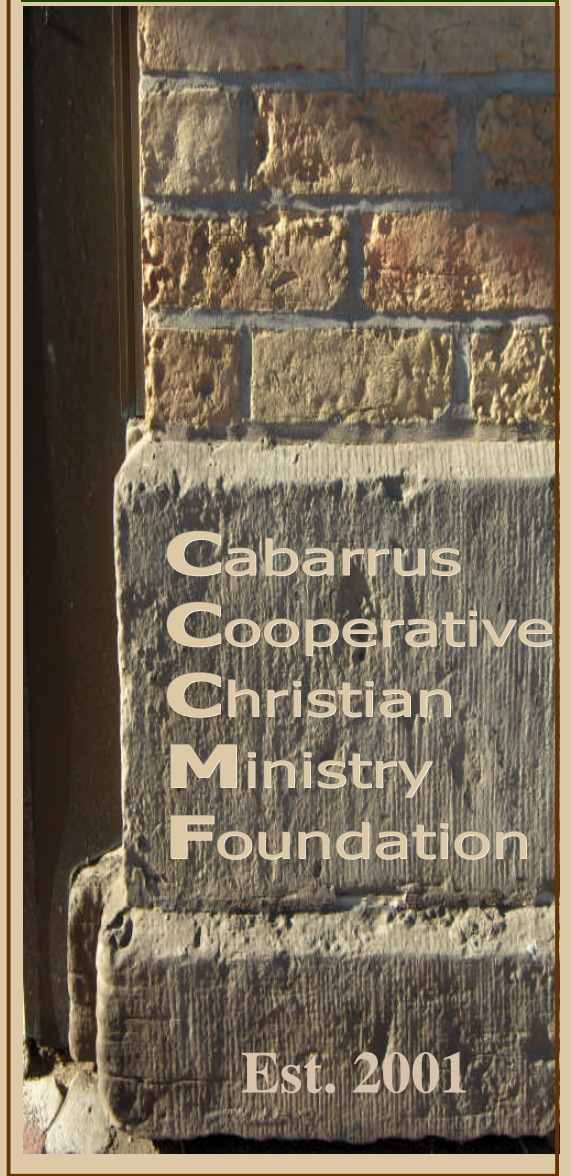
