## Cabarrus Homelessness Indicators

**JANUARY TO DECEMBER 2023**

### Cooperative Christian Ministry

Received **532** applications for housing. A total of **1,465** people in housing crisis, at **2.7** per family. This represents an **18%** increase over the same period in **2022**.

### Cabarrus County and Kannapolis City Schools

Reported **657** students as homeless during 2023/24 school year: a **16%** increase over the same period last year.

### Help with Housing.net

There were **122** applications; **344** people, including **162** children in the **2nd** half of **2023**, an increase of **37%** over the **1st** half of **2023**.

### Cabarrus County Foster Care Program

The number of youths in foster care is **183**. This represents a **16%** increase over **2022**. Ten youth aged out in **2023**.

### Opportunity House

Registered an average of **34** new clients per month— a **6%** increase over **2022**.

### AYA House

AYA House has provided a total of **102** beds— **83** beds for males and **19** beds for females in **2023**. These residents are reentering our community from incarceration, substance abuse treatment, and chronic homelessness.

### Cabarrus County Evictions

There were **1,518** recorded evictions in **2023**, averaging **127** per month, a **50%** increase over **2022**.
