Homeless Indicators

JANUARY TO DECEMBER 2022

Cooperative Christian Ministry

Received **448** applications for housing. A total of **1,256** people in housing crisis, at **2.8** per family.

Cabarrus County and Kannapolis City Schools

Reported **565** students as homeless during the first six months of the 2022/23 school year, compared to **354** students in the same period last year and **318** two years ago.

The Unsheltered Homeless

The January 25th Count of local homeless was **470** people, including **243** children (52%). The count identified **379** sheltered and **91** unsheltered individuals.

Cabarrus County Foster Care Program

The number of youths in foster care was **158** at year end. A total of **eight** youth aged out in 2022. The Open Door House serves females aging out of foster care in Cabarrus County.

Opportunity House

Registered an average of **32** new clients per month, representing **385** new clients in 2022.

AYA House

AYA House has provided beds for **30** unduplicated males and **18** unduplicated females in 2022 - averaging **10** men and **3** women per month. These residents are reentering our community from incarceration, substance abuse treatment and chronic homelessness.

Cabarrus County Evictions

There were **654** recorded evictions in the second half of 2022, averaging **109** per month - a total of **1,013** for the year.
